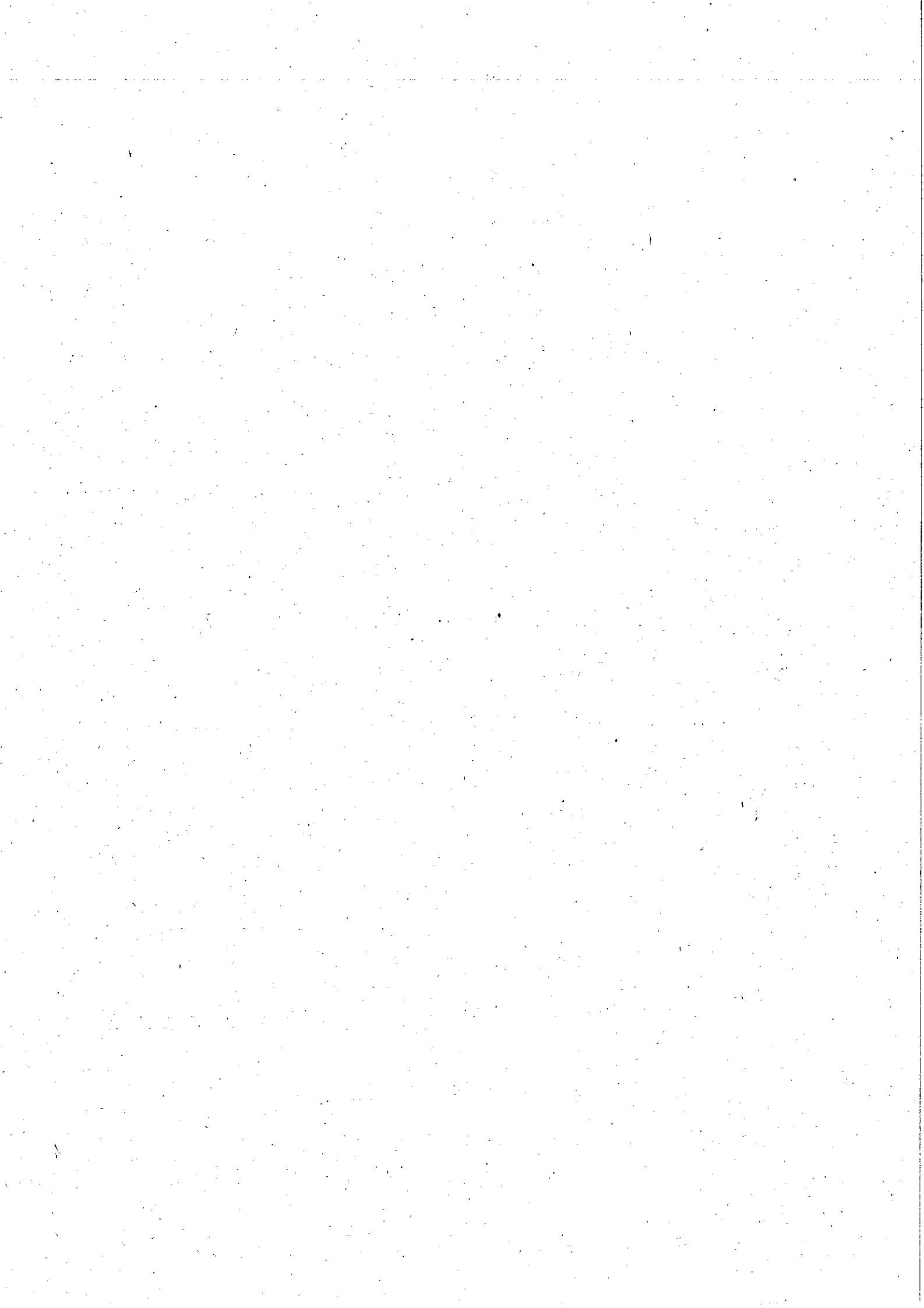

The Government of the Kyrgyz Republic has received financing in the amount of US\$ 46,000,000.00 equivalents from the World Bank toward the cost of the Heat Supply Improvement Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, non-consulting services and consulting services to be procured under this project.

The project will include the following components:

Component 1: Improving supply efficiency and quality of the District Heating system in Bishkek.

Subcomponent 1.1: Investment program for District Heating rehabilitation. For the implementation the investment program project will finance the following key activities:

- (a) modernization of individual (building-level) heat substations, including: i) installation of new individual heat substations in selected buildings; ii) preparation and upgrade of existing heat substations in selected buildings (preliminary estimate US\$ 10.0 million);
- (b) installation of building-level heat and hot water meters (preliminary estimate US\$ 6.9 million); and
- (c) installation of preventive maintenance information system (preliminary estimate US\$ 0.4 million).
- (d) replacement and/or reconstruction of selected sections along the Vostok Transmission Network. (preliminary estimate US\$ 12.4 million)



Subcomponent 1.2: Operational capacity strengthening and Project implementation support for BTS. Under the component project will finance the following key activities:

- (a) strengthening its technical, operational, fiduciary, customer orientation and corporate resource management functions (preliminary estimate US\$ 0.25 million);
- (b) strengthen its capacity for Project management and implementation, including Project ??? and audits, through the provision of goods and consultants' services, as well as financing of Training and Operating Costs (preliminary estimate US\$ 0.7 million).

Component 3: Demonstration of benefits of energy efficiency in public buildings includes the following subcomponents:

Subcomponent 3.1. Investments to ensure energy efficiency and seismic resilience in independent public buildings will be financed in the education and health sector (e.g. schools, kindergartens, hospitals and medical centers). Two key activities will be implemented:

- (a) Energy-efficiency and seismic refurbishment and related technical consulting services (e.g. energy audit, technical and social M&E before and after subproject implementation, technical designs, and supervision of construction works) will be financed under this activity (preliminary estimate US\$ 8.8 million).
- (b) Activities aimed at strengthening local capacity with a view to improve favorable conditions for enhancing energy-efficiency, market opportunities, and awareness of energy efficiency including: local firms training; Information campaign on energy efficiency; and piloting benefit-sharing and co-financing scheme (preliminary estimate US\$ 0.16 million).

Subcomponent 3.2. Operational capacity strengthening and Project implementation support for implementing agency ARIS, including support for: (i) ARIS PIU staff and experts; (ii) related project operating costs and trainings; and (iii) annual audit of Project accounts (preliminary estimate US\$ 1.04 million).

In order to improve energy efficiency, the procurement of goods will include, but not be limited to the following: hybrid heating systems - such as combined photovoltaic (PV) and solar-thermal pumping systems; systems of storing the energy; solar systems installed on the roof of the buildings and/or other measure of energy savings.

The Government of Ukraine has applied for a loan from the World Bank in the amount of USD 382 million equivalent towards the cost of the Ukraine District Heating Energy Efficiency Project (UDHEEP) and intends to apply the proceeds of this loan to the payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under this project. This project will be jointly financed by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (USD 332 million) and Clean Technology Fund (USD 50 million).

The project will be implemented in ten cities of different sizes, namely Chernihiv, Dnipropetrovsk, Donetsk, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kamianets-Podilskyi, Kharkiv, Kherson, Kirovohrad, Mykolaiv and Vinnytsia. Their population ranges from 100,000 to about 1.4 million with the total population of the ten cities amounting to more than 5.5 million.

The project will include the following parts:

Part 1: Improvement of Energy Efficiency (USD 376.5 million). This part will address the rehabilitation and upgrading of district heating systems including the following investments:

\*Rehabilitation of 6,7 km of networks including preparation of design documentation, insulation of 25,6 km of pipelines, rehabilitation of 31 boiler houses and 4 Central Heat Substations (?TP), reconstruction of 1 boiler house, installation of 93 Individual Heat Substations (ITP) and installation of SCADA system in Mykolaiv;

\*Rehabilitation of 2 boiler houses and reconstruction of 4 CTPs, installation of 21 ITPs and 200 heat meters, rehabilitation of 7,6 km of networks including preparation of design documentation and installation of SCADA system for 26 boiler houses in Kherson;

\*Rehabilitation of 52 boiler houses and installation of frequency converter for main pipelines, installation of 300 ITPs and 1000 heat meters, rehabilitation of district heating networks, rehabilitation of 3 CHPs and installation of 2 mini CHPs, closure of 22 boiler houses in Kharkiv;

\*Rehabilitation of 37 km of networks, reconstruction of CHP with replacement of turbine and installation of 300 ITPs in Vinnytsia;

- \*Rehabilitation of 2,2 km of networks, construction of 2 boiler houses and rehabilitation of 3 boiler houses, installation of 67 ITPs and SCADA system in Kamyanets-Podilsky;
- \*Rehabilitation of 25 km of networks, installation of 240 ITPs, rehabilitation of boiler house and installation of SCADA system in Ivano-Frankivsk;
- \*Installation of ITPs, reconstruction of boiler houses with installation of SCADA system and cogeneration unit, rehabilitation of 23,7 km district heating networks in Donetsk;
- \*Rehabilitation and construction of district heating networks, reconstruction of 46 CTPs and installation of 127 ITPs, installation of heat meters and SCADA system in Chernihiv;
- \*Installation of ITPs and heat meters, modernization of boiler houses, rehabilitation of district heating network, installation of SCADA system in Kirovohrad;
- \*Rehabilitation of boiler houses, installation of CTPs and ITPs, rehabilitation of district heating network and installation of SCADA system in Dnepropetrovsk;
- \*Procurement of auxiliary equipment and special vehicles;
- \*Preparation of detailed designs, pre-contracting services and construction supervision services;
- \*Institutional Strengthening and Capacity Building.

Part 2: Project Management and Supervision (USD 5.5 million). This part will finance implementation of the project including incremental operating costs, audit, institutional strengthening and capacity building and feasibility studies of potential district heating improvement investments.

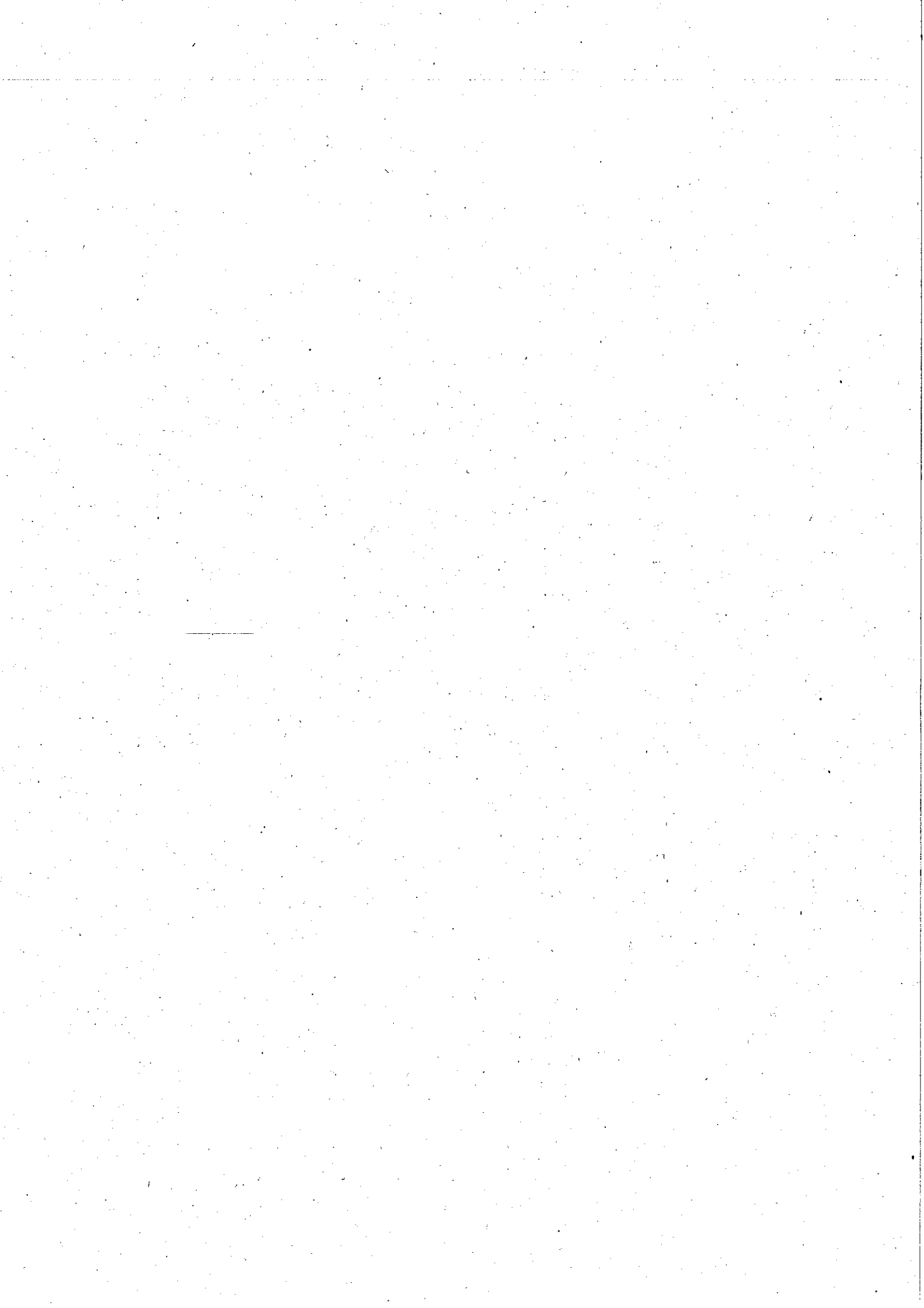

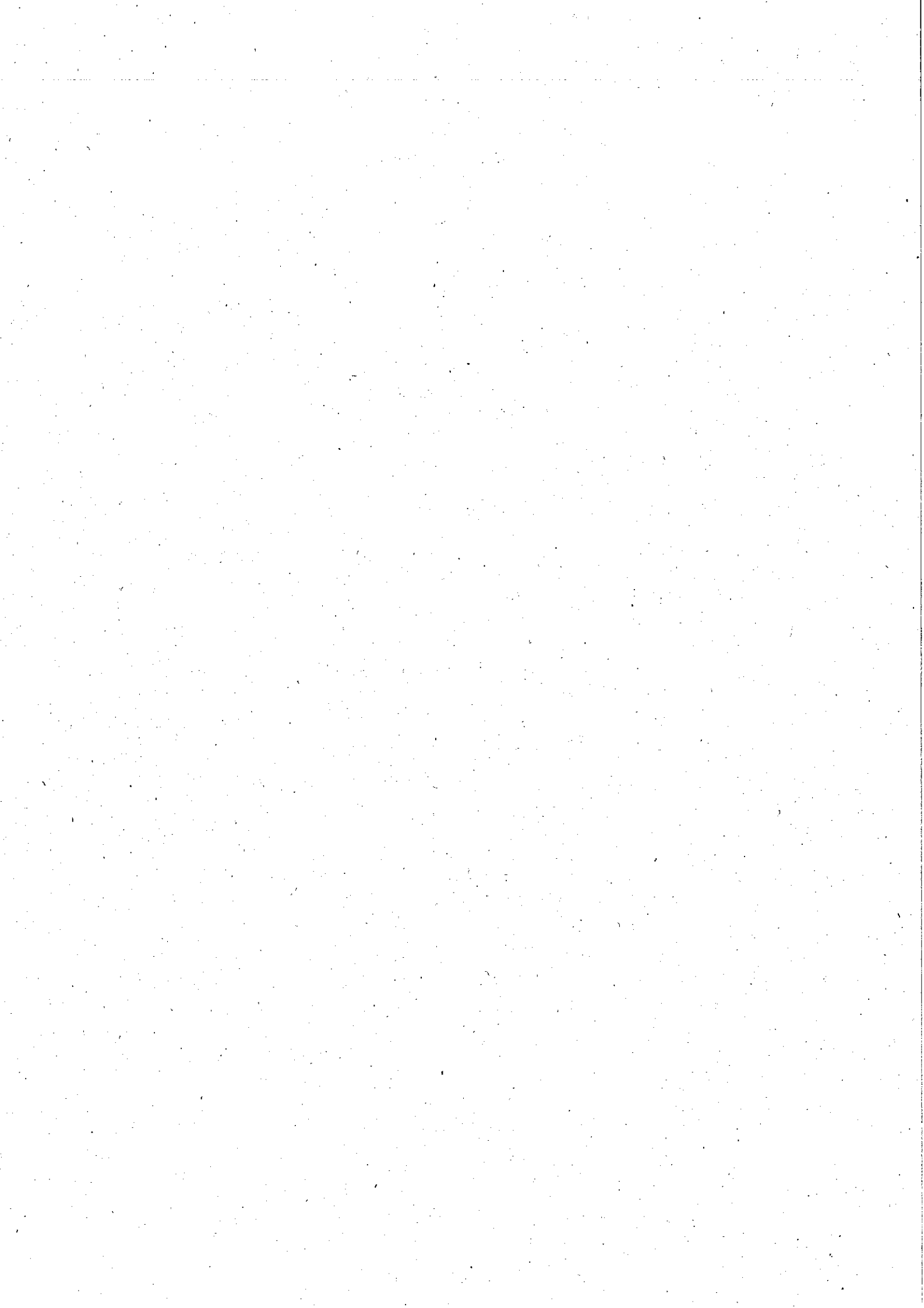
